DATE AND PLACE: BUENOS AIRES, July 9-15, 2017

DURATION: one week, 10 Half-days of conferences with simultaneous translation

TOPICS CONSIDERED:

- Ethics and authenticity: the pillars of the notarial profession
- Fight against money laundering
- Family Law: Comparative Law Study on couples and the role of notary
- Real Estate Law: joint ownership and sale in the future state of completion
- Protection of vulnerable people: disability and protection mandate
- New technologies - Electronic Act and paperless procedures
- International Successions
- Company law: constitution, operation, modification
- The social utility of notaries for the citizens and the State
- The International Union of Notaries (UINL): presentation of the global network and its activities worldwide

GOALS:

1. Promote international exchange between future & young notaries
2. Promote awareness of the globalization of legal relationships
3. Provide high quality practical training to young notaries, allowing them to actually be able to apply the international standards in their legal documents.

STUDENTS: Candidate notaries, notaries trainees and young notaries (<35 years old and less than five years of professional experience), Students in notarial Law except those who have not completed their practical training. **Participants at the World Notariat University are allowed to only one edition. As a result, WNU students of previous editions cannot participate again.**

EXPECTED NUMBER: 1 class of maximum 100 participants.

WORKING LANGUAGES: French/English/Spanish with simultaneous translation.

TERMS OF SELECTION: letter of application and Resume, presented and approved by the Notarial National Council + final selection by the UINL.

Maximum 5 students per country.

REGISTRATION FEES: 100,00€ per participant

Registration fees are payable by bank transfer or cash once the application is validated by the UINL.

FUNDINGS:

- Training (including course materials) provided by the UINL, the UNA and, if any, partners
- Transportation, housing and related expenses paid by the students, their Office or their National Notary Council.

TEACHING METHOD:

- A half-day class, by speakers from two different countries, if possible one notary and one teacher
- Format:
 - o Theoretical Background Basics (40 min)
 - o Discussion on the different legal systems of the Students group (40 min)
 - o International and Comparative Law practice example (60 min)
 - o Q & A (40 min)
- Class should be "informal" and interactive.
- Course materials must be varied and allow interactivity (notarized act draft, videos, power point, etc.)

RELATED PLANNED VISITS (To be confirmed by the UNA and the Argentine Notariat):

- Meetings with the local notaries, Faculty of Law, Argentinian University of Notaries and its students
- Visits to a notary's office, to the Federal Council of Notaries of Argentina
- Various tours: Ministry of Justice, Courts, Supreme Court, etc.
- Optional Social Program
